



Protect Your Identity While Using Mobile Apps

Now that more of you are making transactions using mobile apps and devices, including smartphones and tablets, KCFCU wants to remind you to take measures to protect your identity. Here are a few basic tips:

Use Strong Passwords – Use at least 10 characters with a combination of upper and lowercase letters, plus numbers and symbols.


Protect Your Personal Information

Use privacy settings on your social media accounts to limit who can see details about your life.

Keep Your System Software Updated Software updates often include fixes that provide greater security.

Review Your Statements – Whether you choose eStatements or printed statements, review them each month to look for suspicious transactions.

If you suspect that you've been a victim of fraud or identity theft, let your financial institution know immediately and report the incident to your local police and state authorities. You can report the incident to your state Attorney General at www.naag.org and to the FBI Internet Crime Complaint Center at: www.ic3.gov/default.aspx
