

## **NEW CardNav Payment Card App Offers Smart Fraud Protection**

Thanks to intuitive new mobile apps like CardNav by CO-OP®, you can enjoy greater peace of mind, control and security on your KCFCU Visa® Check Card.

CardNav lets you use your smartphone to keep your checking account safe and prevent fraud. CardNav is available for both Android and iPhones.

This smart mobile app allows you to:

- Control when and where your check card can be used by locking and unlocking your card
- Receive instant alerts to notify you of any unauthorized use
- Set limits on family member purchases to avoid misuse
- Track monthly spending at a glance
- Access and manage check card anytime, anywhere

### Is CardNav Secure?

Absolutely! The CardNav mobile app does not store sensitive information, such as card numbers, PIN or passwords. Each time you use the app, you must provide your login credentials. You can also deactivate the app remotely to stop any unauthorized access.

You can download CardNav at your device's App store. Once downloaded, you can access simple instructions on how to use CardNav and all its features.

## Beware of These Top Scams Reported to the BBB

To protect consumers from scammers attempting to steal our money or our identities, the Better Business Bureau (BBB) introduced "Scam Tracker." It's a special tool that allows consumers to report suspected scams. The following are among the most frequently reported scams on Scam Tracker:

**Tax Scam.** This scam typically is a phone call from a person who claims to be from the IRS. They claim you owe money in taxes and that you could face arrest or a lawsuit, if you don't pay.

**Debt Collection Scam.** You get a phone call from someone who claims you have an unpaid debt. The caller may threaten you with wage garnishments, a lawsuit or jail, if you don't pay immediately.

**Sweepstakes or Gift Scam.** Typically a letter, email or phone call in which the fraudster states that you have won a sweepstakes prize or other randomly selected gift. You are instructed to pay a fee to cover the delivery of the prize.

**Tech Support Scam.** You may be contacted by a bogus "Microsoft" or "Apple" tech support person who says they have detected a virus or security breach in your computer. They try to convince you to pay a fee and give them your log-on information, so they can login and correct the problem remotely.

**Credit Card Scam.** The caller pretends to be an employee from your bank or credit union. They tell you that you are eligible to lower your credit card interest rates or they need to verify a credit card transaction. They are really just trying to get your credit card number and security code.

**Expert Advice.** Unless you initiate the call or you are 100% certain you are speaking with a trustworthy caller, DO NOT initiate a payment or give out any account or personal information. Always protect sensitive information, such as credit card numbers, passwords, driver's license and Social Security Numbers.
