We are here to strengthen our community, to enrich our members' lives and to remind ourselves every single day that this is a family. This is the promise of Gather Federal Credit Union—our promise to you.





## Solid Financial Performance and a New Identity

Our community credit union celebrated another successful year in 2017, and we're moving forward in 2018 with a new identity and bright outlook for the future.

Assets grew by \$27 million (5.90%); Member Savings grew by \$22 million (5.49%); Loans grew by \$27 million (11.66%). Net income for the year amounted to \$3.3 million. Now at \$486 million in assets, with \$267 million in loans to members and total member savings of \$434 million, your credit union remains financially stable and sound.

Throughout 2017, we continued to promote financial literacy, offering educational classes ranging from Understanding Your Credit Score to the ABC's of Home Ownership. We opened our third student credit union at Waimea High School and supported Bank Bus days at several elementary schools.

We also supported our community partners, donating to or volunteering for nearly 100 different charitable organizations. Our annual golf tournament raised \$36,000 for Wilcox Pediatric Services on Kauai via the Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network. To fight hunger in our communities, Kauai's credit unions collectively donated \$37,000 to the Kauai Independent Food Bank, with \$17,000 of that total coming from KCFCU.

To continue improving your banking experience, renovations are in progress at three of our branch offices. Our Kapaa office is undergoing an extensive remodel, and our Eleele and Waimea offices will also be updated. New state of the art ATMs will be installed in the coming months at all five office locations.

### We've Been Doing It for 64 Years. KCFCU Is Now Gather FCU!

Renaming KCFCU to Gather FCU was a very big step. To make sure we got it right, we reached out for input and feedback from the membership and community over a two-year period. Rest assured, we are not changing our staff, business hours, account numbers or our full-service approach to serving your financial needs. Only our name has changed—not who we are.

To remain relevant with current and future generations, we must reach out and adapt to new opportunities. Our name change and brand refresh embrace this mindset. We are local, and will always be local, but in order to protect your assets and trust in us, we need to think globally.

The name "Gather" links us to our past, yet represents a brand promise to our members and community. Looking back at our original ten pineapple farmers who gathered in 1954 to pool \$595 to establish this credit union, we will be forever grateful for their commitment and sense of community.

Although we are a financial institution, Gather FCU is also a family—a family that has been dedicated to serving you for 64 years, and we promise to continue that dedication for many more years to come. Watch for a gradual transition to our new logo on interior and exterior signage, as well as on our marketing materials!





## Scams Are on the Rise... and They're Happening Here on Kauai!

Thousands of people each year lose money to telephone scams. These losses range from just a few dollars to life savings. Phone scammers will say anything to cheat anyone out of money. Callers are friendly and claim to work for a company you trust.

Here are just a few of the common phone scam offers to watch out for:

- Free travel packages
- Lower your credit card interest rate
- Charitable causes
- Free trial offers
- Foreign lotteries
- Business and investment opportunities
- Foreign job offers that ask for your personal information and resume

If you get a call from someone who is trying to sell you something you hadn't



planned to buy or they pressure you for personal information, such as your credit card or Social Security number to update your account, it's more than likely a scam. Hang up and report it to the Federal Trade Commission.

## Watch Out for Text Message Phishing or "Smishing" Scams

"Call back now to reactivate your credit card," or "Be the first person to visit this link and win a free gaming system!" Text messages like these are quick to grab attention. Scammers know this and target us with "phishing" scams via text message or SMS (short message service).

Text message phishing or "smishing" occurs when scam artists use deceptive text messages to lure consumers into providing their personal or financial information.

These criminals often impersonate a government agency, bank or other known company to trick you. The messages will ask consumers to provide usernames and passwords, credit and debit card numbers, PINs or other sensitive information they can use to commit fraud. Remember the following:

- Legitimate companies never ask for personal or financial information via text or email.
- Don't click on links in unsolicited texts, which are designed to steal personal or financial information stored on your device.
- Don't call a phone number in any unsolicited text message or respond to it for ANY reason.
