I want to thank everyone who attended our 68th Annual Membership Meeting. This year, we were able to host some members in person, while others attended virtually. It's always invigorating to see everyone come together, and it's a chance for us to share the good work Gather FCU has been doing on behalf of our members.

2021 was our second year of record growth, a testament to our membership community and the power of the credit union model. Our assets grew by \$92 million; our member savings grew by \$94 million and loans increased by \$20 million. Gather's net income for the year 2021 amounted to \$5.5 million, all of which was transferred to our reserves, ensuring our credit union is safe and sound.

We're excited to announce that our new in-store branch is now open in the Līhu'e Walmart (in the space formerly occupied by McDonald's). We listened to you and, as a result, opened our new branch with extended hours six days a week. The Līhu'e Walmart in-store branch is open Monday–Saturday, 9am–6pm. The former Līhu'e office space on Hardy Street will now be used for administrative and professional services. However, the Hardy Street full-service ATM is still available for use.

# **Identity Security 101**

It's a fact of life—fraud is real, and it can happen to anyone. Identity theft—when a criminal uses another person's identity without permission, including names, credit card numbers, Social Security numbers, etc.—is one of the most devastating and insidious forms of fraud. With this info, criminals can apply for credit, go shopping and more.

There are simple steps you can take to be safe. Never share personal information, such as date of birth, Social Security numbers or bank account numbers, unless you're certain of who you're sharing it with. Use strong passwords on all accounts, change them regularly and avoid using public Wi-Fi for personal or financial business.
