### Gather Comes to Līhu'e Walmart



New full-service Gather in-store branch office opens in Līhu'e Walmart in April 2022.

At Gather FCU, we're always working to improve the experience of our members, including products and services, hours of operation, security and technology, staff and branch office locations.

We're pleased to announce the opening of our newest office in April 2022, located inside the Līhu'e Walmart at 3-3300 Kuhio Hwy., in the space formerly held by McDonald's. This full-service branch office (minus a drive-thru) will provide a convenient location with extended hours: Monday–Saturday, 9am to 6pm.

"It's a convenient location for many of our members and we hope it will give even more people the opportunity to join Gather FCU," says President/CEO Tess Shimabukuro.

With the opening of our new Walmart branch, the Gather Līhu'e office at 4434 Hardy St. will close on **Monday**, **February 28, 2022**. We know many members hold a fondness for the Hardy St. branch office. Rest assured, you will see the same familiar employees' faces from the Hardy St. office, as they assume roles at other locations.

Those who use the ATM on Hardy St. can continue to do so. The ATM will remain.

"The decision to close the Hardy St. office came only after an in-depth analysis of what works best for our members," said Shimabukuro. "Throughout the entire process, our leadership never lost sight of our #1 priority: Maintaining the exceptional member service you have come to expect from Gather."

Gather will still have six locations—two in Līhu'e at Walmart and Kukui Grove, as well as offices in Kapa'a, Kōloa, 'Ele'ele and Waimea.

## **InstaScams**

### Social Media Scams Are on the Rise

Social media allows everyone to stay more connected. Unfortunately, it's also allowed scammers to get more sophisticated. Stay alert and avoid these common social media scams:

- Direct message from a familiar account, but asks you to click on a link.
- Message from someone you don't know requesting money.
- Message from Instagram security asking for account information.
- Unverified accounts from supposed large companies or public figures.
  - Verified accounts always have a blue badge with a checkmark near the name.



- People or accounts asking you to claim a prize.
- Request to move your conversation off Instagram to a less secure setting.
- Messages with poor spelling or grammatical errors.


