Your Deposits Are Protected at Gather FCU

It's easy to get swept up in the news when a bank fails, and it's important to understand what happened and why. When you look beneath the surface, however, it's easy to see that the three big banks in the news in the past few months were already in a precarious position.

They grew very quickly by taking on more risk than they usually would have. They also took on a lot of uninsured deposits from sources that are generally less stable than traditional banks.

Credit unions, on the other hand, are not-for-profit cooperatives owned by members, and serve the interests of their members. They operate very differently than a bank. Credit unions take on fewer risks and focus on individuals rather than large investors.

We understand how to manage risk, so you can rest easy knowing your money is safe and secure. We work hard to keep our funding stable and diverse, so you can feel confident about where your money is going. And we focus on the things that matter most: great service, reasonable fees and making sure your money is insured by the National Credit Union Association (NCUA), an agency of the federal government.

Credit unions have protections in place to keep your money safe and their financial institutions secure. Deposits at a credit union are protected by the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund (NCUSIF). This is a separate fund, not associated with the FDIC, which insures bank deposits. Your deposits are insured for up to \$250,000 per individual. For more information about the NCUSIF, visit MyCreditUnion.gov.

Protect Your Accounts

You Should Never Give Out Your Password

There's no end to the creativity of scam artists when it comes to stealing your money. And all it takes is a stolen password



to provide access to your accounts. One of the newer frauds making the rounds involves the threat of a "frozen account." Scammers will email, text or call stating that your account will be frozen immediately unless you provide your password. If this happens to you, don't even respond and definitely do not give out your password to anyone.

No matter how urgent the message sounds, if an unsolicited email, text or call is asking for your password or other personal information, it's definitely a scam. Gather FCU would never ask for your password, and we would never contact you in this way. If you are concerned, you can always call Gather to verify. Keep your password to yourself and you'll keep your money safe.
