

Scholarship Program

At Gather FCU we strongly endorse the pursuit of higher education. That is why we offer up to fifteen (15) \$2,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors.

All graduating high school seniors planning to enroll full time in any two (2) or four (4) year institution of higher education are eligible. Recipients <u>must</u> be enrolled as full-time students, be <u>members of the credit union</u> for at least <u>6 months prior</u> to the application deadline, in good standing and willing to have their picture published.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school of the student's choice for educational expenses such as tuition, books, fees, supplies, room, and board. If the student does not enroll in the fall semester, the scholarship funds must be returned.

For consideration of a scholarship, the following criteria will be used:

- 1. Academic Merit
- 2. Community Service
- 3. Credit Union Relationship
- 4. Financial Need

Frequently Asked Questions & Answers

Am I eligible to apply?

An applicant <u>must</u> be a member of Gather Federal Credit Union for <u>6 months prior</u> to the application deadline, accepted and plan to enroll full-time at an institution of higher learning in the upcoming fall semester. You are a member if you receive a statement with your name listed (primary member) and have a regular share account with at least \$5.

Can my parent, grandparent, or guardian apply for me?

No. You, the applicant must apply yourself.

How do I apply?

Send the following to the Scholarship Committee at Gather Federal Credit Union, 4493 Pahe'e Street, Lihue, Hawaii 96766:

- 1. Completed Scholarship Application Form
- 2. Completed Checklist and Signatures Form
- 3. Completed Honors, Advanced Placement (AP), Running Start (RS), Early College (EC) Form
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- 5. Official Transcripts. Must be enclosed (envelope sealed) with your scholarship packet or mailed directly by your High School no later than the application deadline to the following:

- 6. Completed School, Extra-Curricular and Community Activities Form
- 7. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation (One Academic and One Non-School Related)
- 8. Personal Essay

Only <u>completed</u> entries will be considered. All documents should be sent in one envelope, postmarked no later than <u>March 15, 2026</u>.

Are there any deadlines?

A completed application must be postmarked by <u>March 15, 2026</u>, prior to the fall semester you will be enrolled as a student. Late submissions will not be considered.

When will I be notified?

Scholarship applicants will be notified via email/mail no later than May 30.

If I am awarded a scholarship, do I get the check?

Yes, the check will be made payable to <u>you and the school</u> that you enroll in for the fall semester. If you do not enroll in the fall semester you must return the scholarship funds.

Are there any marketing requirements expected of me if I am awarded a scholarship?

Yes, the recipient is expected to be part of a press release and have their photo printed in a local and

possibly national publication.

Can I contest the selection?

No, the Scholarship Committee selections will be final.

What can my scholarship be used for?

Any and all educational expenses such as tuition, books, fees, supplies, room and board, and miscellaneous school expenses.

Is the scholarship taxable?

Consult a tax expert for advice.

How will the Scholarship Committee know if a transcript is "official"?

Your academic institution should seal the official transcript in an envelope bearing the academic institution's address and/or logo with your name on the outside.

If the transcript says "unofficial or not signed by your academic institution," it will <u>not</u> be included; your application will be incomplete.

Who should my 2 letters of recommendation come from?

Your two (2) letters of recommendation should be from individuals not related to or living with you. <u>Letter #1</u> needs to be someone from the Department of Education, such as Faculty Member, Counselor, etc. <u>Letter #2</u> needs to be from someone outside of the Department of Education, such as a coach, pastor, mentor, etc.

What should I say in my personal essay?

Anything and everything including why you are deserving of a scholarship, something about yourself, your beliefs, your future goals/plans, or your pursuit of this education. The essay should be typed, double-spaced, a minimum of 12-point text and no more than 2 pages in length.

May I receive more than one scholarship from Gather Federal Credit Union?

No.

If I do not receive a scholarship this year, may I apply again next year?

No. This scholarship is only for graduating high school seniors.

What if I am home schooled?

As long as your application is complete, you're eligible for a Gather FCU scholarship

Does the Committee always award up to fifteen (15) scholarships?

Not always. The Scholarship Committee may award <u>up to</u> fifteen (15) \$2,000 scholarships based on qualified applicants only.
